## THE EUROPEAN COMMISSION,

Having regard to the Treaty on the Functioning of the European Union,

Having regard to Regulation (EU) 2015/2283 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 25 November 2015 on novel foods, amending Regulation (EU) No 1169/2011 of the European Parliament and of the Council and repealing Regulation (EC) No 258/97 of the European Parliament and of the Council and Commission Regulation (EC) No 1852/2001<sup>1</sup>, and in particular Article 12 thereof,

#### Whereas:

- (1) Regulation (EU) 2015/2283 provides that only novel foods authorised and included in the Union list of novel foods may be placed on the market within the Union.
- (2) Pursuant to Article 8 of Regulation (EU) 2015/2283, Commission Implementing Regulation (EU) 2017/2470<sup>2</sup> has established a Union list of novel foods.
- (3) The Union list set out in the Annex to Implementing Regulation (EU) 2017/2470 includes *Jatropha curcas* L. (edible variety) kernels as an authorised novel food.
- (4) Commission Implementing Regulation (EU) 2022/965<sup>3</sup> authorised the placing on the market of *Jatropha curcas* L. (edible variety) kernels as a novel food.
- (5) On 9 May 2023, the company Chuta Nut GmbH ('the applicant') submitted an application to the Commission in accordance with Article 10(1) of Regulation (EU) 2015/2283 to change the conditions of use and the specifications of the novel food *Jatropha curcas* L. (edible variety) kernels. The applicant requested to include two additional forms of the novel food *Jatropha curcas* L. (edible variety) kernels, kernels as flour and kernels as paste, both consisting of 100% ground kernels) and to increase the maximum use levels of the novel food from 5 g/100 g to 30 g/100 g in the previously authorised food categories. Additionally, the applicant requested the

- change in the specifications that aims at increasing the fat content range (from 54%–61% to 54%–64%) in the final novel food.
- (6) On 19 January 2024, the Commission requested the European Food Safety Authority ('the Authority') to provide a scientific opinion on the change of the conditions of use and the specifications of the novel food *Jatropha curcas* L. (edible variety) kernels.
- (7) On 29 September 2025, the Authority adopted its scientific opinion on the 'Safety of changes in the conditions of use and the specifications of edible *Jatropha curcas* L. (Chuta) as a novel food pursuant to Regulation (EU) 2015/2283<sup>4</sup> in accordance with Article 11 of Regulation (EU) 2015/2283.
- (8) In its scientific opinion, the Authority concluded that the novel food, *Jatropha curcas* L. (edible variety) kernels, flour and paste, is safe under the new proposed conditions of use and the specifications.
- (9) The information provided in the application and the Authority's scientific opinion give sufficient grounds to establish that the changes to the conditions of use and the specifications of *Jatropha curcas* L. (edible variety) kernels are in accordance with Article 12(1) of Regulation (EU) 2015/2283 and should be approved.
- (10) The Annex to Implementing Regulation (EU) 2017/2470 should therefore be amended accordingly.
- (11) The measures provided for in this Regulation are in accordance with the opinion of the Standing Committee on Plants, Animals, Food and Feed,

### HAS ADOPTED THIS REGULATION:

#### Article 1

The Annex to Implementing Regulation (EU) 2017/2470 is amended in accordance with the Annex to this Regulation.

### Article 2

Only the company Chuta Nut GmbH<sup>5</sup> is authorised to place on the market within the Union the novel food referred to in Article 1, for a period of 5 years from [the date of entry into force of this Regulation] [OP please insert the date], unless a subsequent applicant obtains an authorisation for the novel food without reference to the scientific data protected pursuant to Article 3 or with the agreement of the company Chuta Nut GmbH.

#### Article 3

The scientific data contained in the application file and fulfilling the conditions laid down in Article 26(2) of Regulation (EU) 2015/2283 shall not be used for the benefit of a subsequent applicant for a period of 5 years from the date of entry into force of this Regulation without the agreement of the company Chuta Nut GmbH.
