<u>ANNEX</u>

Specification of *Clostridium butyricum* (CBM 588)

Definition: *Clostridium butyricum* (CBM 588) is a gram-positive, spore forming, obligate anaerobic, non-pathogenic, non-genetically modified bacterium.

Description: White or pale grey tablets with characteristic odour and sweet taste.

Microbiological criteria:

Total viable aerobic count	Not more than 10 ³ CFU/g
Escherichia coli	Not detected in 1 g
Staphylococcus aureus	Not detected in 1 g
Pseudomonas aeruginosa	Not detected in 1 g
Yeast and moulds	Not more than 10^2 CFU/g
