Note on consultation regarding the plan and Strategic Environment Assessment for the tender/tenders or open door for geological storage of CO₂ in the northwestern part of the North Sea in Denmark

The Danish Energy Agency (DEA) is planning a tender/tenders or open door of licensing for geological storage of CO₂ in the areas west of 6° 15' E and north of 56° 00' N. DEA has prepared a strategic environment assessment (SEA) of the plan. In accordance with Articles 4 and 5 of the Espoo Convention on Environmental Impact Assessment in a Transboundary Context (Espoo Convention), the SEA has been in consultation in Germany and Norway.

March 18 2022 a consultation letter and SEA documentation was send to Norway and Germany, in order to give the opportunity for consultations and public participation (Article 10). The consultation period ran from March 18 2022 – April 27 2022 along with the Danish public hearing. Germany requested a prolonging of the submission deadline. DEA met this request with a prolonging of the deadline to May 30 2022.

DEA has received an answer from Norway with no comments. DEA has received no comments from Germany.
